On Wednesday October 6, our parish will be honoured with the arrival of the relic of the heart of St. John Vianney, Patron of Priests. 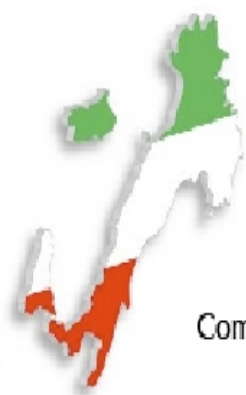
