


Easter Prayer For Family

Vive le français et vive l'immersion française à Fatima et au Canada!!




























GRADE THREE ENGLISH






These are the hands which,

me.










Students in grade 4 English are learning about their personal identities. They created faces that showed their physical features on one half the face, and their skills, traits and attributes on the other half.
