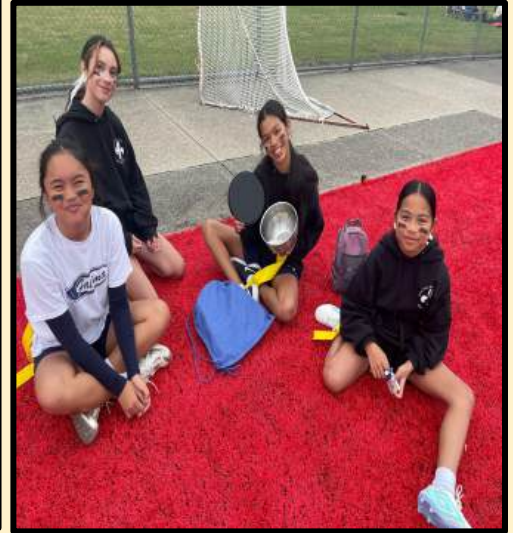

Flag Football Tournament

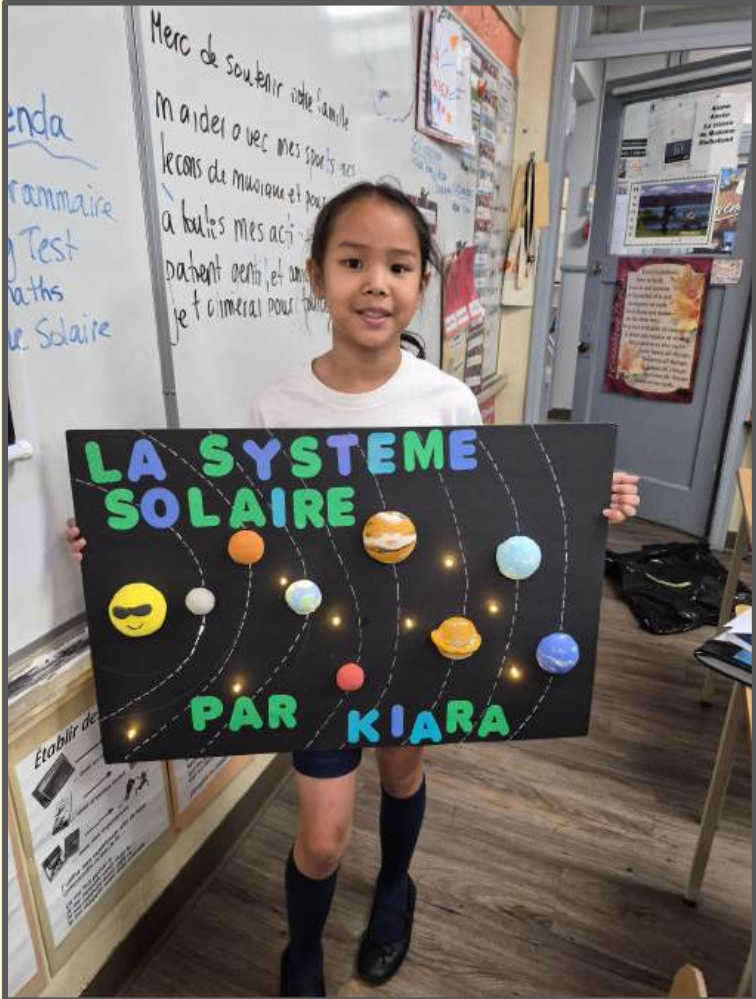
